

Freedom of Information at The Edinburgh International Festival

✖ The Scottish Information Commissioner is to explore the impact that the FOI 'right to information' has had in Scotland at event, 'Freedom of Information – What Difference Has It Made?' taking place on 21st August 2010.

At the event, part of the Scottish Parliament's 2010 Festival of Politics, Kevin Dunion will discuss what has been achieved by FOI since it came into force in 2005. He will be joined by a panel of people who have successfully used FOI to make a difference in their own communities and beyond.
