Scotland's Solicitor General has heaped praise on the work of Victim Support Scotland and thanked the charity on behalf of prosecutors across the country. The charity this year celebrates 25 years in existence.

Frank Mulholland QC, addresssing the 2010 VSS Annual General Meeting in the City Chambers, Glasgow yesterday said that partnership working between the Crown Office Procurator Fiscal's Office (COPFS) and Victim Support Scotland meant that victims were now at the heart of criminal justice in Scotland.
