A \$65m out of court settlement to the awesomely handsome and already outrageously wealthy Winklevoss twins was a mere drop in the ocean by the time it was paid. Justin Timberlake is a surprisingly believable Sean Parker, the founder of Napster and Jesse Eisenberg is a very likeable and acceptably geeky Zuckerberg. Harvard cannot really be too pleased about the way it portrays its institution, nor can White House adviser to the Treasury and former Harvard Dean, Larry Summers, be too happy.
