<u>Underclass</u> have been developing their bluesey, electronic tinged indie rock for a year now, and with sing-along choruses and soaring vocals, their songs are destined to take them far. <u>Maydays</u> are originally from Wick, and having regrouped in Edinburgh for a short while are now scattered all over Scotland. As a result of this they don't play often, so this is a unique chance to listen to their Belle and Sebastianesque offerings.
