A fleet of dozens of classic Bentleys from all over the world will be on display in the heart of Edinburgh's Old Town today. 

At 11am, the [Britain by Bentley](#) tour, featuring a large contingent of cars from the UK, Australia, New Zealand, Japan and many more countries, will be formally welcomed to Scotland's Capital by The Rt. Hon. George Grubb, Lord Provost of the City of Edinburgh.

Up to fifty cars, some dating from the 1920s and 30s, will then take pride of place on the Royal Mile for much of the day.
