

Friends of the Earth welcome the decision on Edinburgh trams

Friends of the Earth Scotland has responded to reports that the City of Edinburgh Council [has voted to continue with the Edinburgh trams project](#) last night.

The trams will, once delivered, reduce car journeys and traffic congestion, improve on-street air quality and reduce pollution levels, and help to cut carbon emissions. The decision to take the initial tram line to St. Andrew’s Square is plain common sense, and I applaud those City of Edinburgh Councillors who saw sense and voted for this.”
