

New shop opening at Craigleith

Outdoors clothing specialist Trespass is the latest addition to the line-up of retailers at Craigleith Shopping Park in Edinburgh.

The leisure brand has opened a 3,075 sq ft store in the retail park which is home to high street brands including NEXT, Marks & Spencer, New Look, Wallis, Mama's & Papa's and TK Maxx.
