<u>Scrap Brain</u>, the Edinburgh-based female-fronted noise-pop trio, have released a music video for their song *Take It*.

The video was filmed at <u>Stevenson College</u> as part of a project by a group of film students, and the featured song was recorded at the same site. It features the band performing the song live in a sound studio, with typical live performance chaos.

Scrap Brain formed in March 2010, and their achievements include performing at Glasgow's legendary <u>King Tuts Wah Wah Hut</u> and winning the New Found Sound Friday Night Live 2010 competition.

Their music is inspired by late 90s grunge bands like Garbage and The Vines, and hi-fi female fronted post-punk like The Kills and Yeah Yeah Yeahs. The band is made up of front woman and performer Angie Clarke, drummer Stewart McLachlan, and multi-instrumentalist Myke Hall, formerly of indie-punks The One Day Speakers.
