Protesters set up camp in Edinburgh

Around 30 anti-greed protesters camped out overnight in **Edinburgh's** St Andrew Square. ■

Saturday had seen approximately 200 people gather in the square to support the <u>Occupy Edinburgh</u> campaign. The group intends to maintain a permanent presence there, and this morning there were a number of tents in evidence.

The event was one of hundreds held in cities throughout the world. While some larger protests such as that in Rome errupted into violence the event in Edinburgh was largely peaceful.

The protesters plan to remain in Edinburgh for the forseeable future as they feel the longer they stay then it will become harder for the authorities to move them on. The campaign started in America with the <u>Occupy Wall Street</u> group and has spread to other major cities acroos the world including London, Rome and Glasgow.
