Virginie has been involved with 'The Daughters of Charity' in some time:-"I sponsor 800 orphans staying at orphanages of "The Daughters of Charity" in the north of Ethiopia. It costs £60 per year per child to get one meal a day. Those children are orphans due to poverty, illness, war…It is not long since the war with Eritrea was finished.

Ethiopia is home to nearly 5 million orphans..unfortunately the government is not doing much for those children simply because there is no money at all. And according to the nuns, all the sponsors from the U.S and Europe are reducing their donations due to the global economic climate...

So far I have given them just under £15,000, most of it my own personal funds. I plan to go back around February/March time."
