She added: "We have all got our fingers crossed that Jack wins this highly prestigious award, which will sit very nicely alongside his other trophies.

"Jack is such a hard-working, generous child who deserves all the recognition he is getting. At the end of last year we presented Jack with our own special award to commemorate his tremendous achievement in completing 500 drawings and raising more than £30,000, an incredible amount of money especially considering his initial target was to raise £100 for the charity!

"Since hedgehogs are all hibernating at this time of year, we thought it would be nice for Jack to have one of his favourite animals in the garden all year round as a reminder of his fantastic contribution to the Sick Kids Friends Foundation.
