The [Junior Award Scheme Scotland](#) (JASS) is an accredited learning programme for young people (P6-S2). There are three levels (bronze, silver and gold), each requiring a higher degree of commitment. Each level also includes four sections to be completed:

- My interest – a hobby or interest
- Get Active, Stay Active – involvement in a sport or physical activity
- Me and My World – a community or environmental project
- Adventure – a teamwork challenge through involvement in an outdoor activity

JASS can be used as part of the school curriculum or to take account of out-of-school activities, and can be delivered in youth work settings.
