

UK Supreme Court rejects appeal by David Gilroy



Gilroy refused legal review of his case.

The UK Supreme Court in London yesterday refused an application by convicted murderer David Gilroy to have his case reviewed.

In April 2012, Gilroy was sentenced to life imprisonment, having been found guilty by a jury at a trial at Edinburgh High Court of murdering Suzanne Pilley and for attempting to defeat the ends of justice.

He was ordered to serve at least 18 years in custody as the punishment part of this sentence.

Suzanne Pilley's body has never been found.
