

Britannia tour – now in 27 languages



The Royal Yacht *Britannia* can now boast the title of the World's most translated audio tour. Brazilian Portuguese, Turkish, Thai, Cantonese and Punjabi have been added this year to *Britannia's* growing list of languages, bringing the total to 27 – more than any other tourist attraction in the world.
