Jim will be making a long waited debut at the Edinburgh Fringe with an hour of comedy, in a show entitled 'No Further Action'. He will be performing at Rainy Hall, Assembly Hall from 1 – 24 August 2014.

Alongside hosting much loved shows such as Big Break and The Generation Game, Jim's sell-out theatre tours and pantomimes have broken box office records and received critical acclaim.

During the 80's Jim travelled the world performing for the troops, taking his top quality entertainment to some of the most inhospitable places imaginable. For this he was awarded an OBE. Now his time in Big Brother has come to an end, this brilliant comedian is back where he belongs – on stage, entertaining audiences.
