Police cordon lifted in Leith

➤ Police Scotland have confirmed that material has been removed from an address in Leith this afternoon, following a search conducted as part of an ongoing operation.

The material is likely to be destroyed by way of a small, controlled explosion carried out by the Army's Explosive Ordnance Disposal.
