This week The Rt Hon Alan Duncan MP, Minister for International Development, visited Holy Rood High School in connection with the Connecting Classrooms programme (a British Council programme, funded by DFID).

The school's African Partnership has benefited over the years from grants from the British Council. This has enabled Holy Rood staff to visit Lombeta and vice versa.
