[Beer and Skittles](#)

With the motto 'travel the world one beer at a time' this bar is a sure fire winner. This new sports bar opened a couple of months ago on Picardy place in the basement of Steak Restaurant. They have plenty of widescreen TVs, booths you can reserve, a free pool table, terrace and beer cocktails! Drinks please – Quilmes or an Erdinger Weisse depending where your money lies.

The infamous Three Sisters in the Grassmarket always has sport on and lots of room to find a seat. You can now pre-book space in the World Cup beer hall and enjoy a 2 pint Stein and a Man Plank – which is a huge sharer board with nachos, burgers, wings and more!
