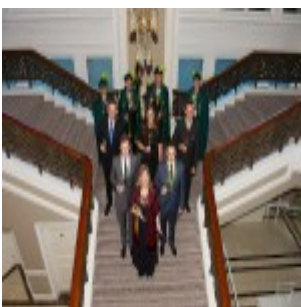


# The Caley will open your wine with a flourish!
