

'Goal Machine' David Gray aims to update his CV



'Goal Machine' David Gray has added a new skill to his cv this season by scoring twice for Hibs, a contrast to his previous 110 plus starts in England during spells with Manchester United, Plymouth Argyle (loan), Preston, Stevenage and Burton, where he never found the net.

Speaking to Hibs TV, Gray said: "I had played quite a few games down south and never scored, so to come up here and finally get the goals has been good.
