Hibs' Head Coach Alan Stubbs is determined that his players won't suffer a 'hangover' following last week's defeat to Falkirk which ended the club's unbeaten run.

Hibs face Alloa Athletic at Easter Road on Saturday and both absentees Liam Craig and Dominique Malonga are available for selection after missing the Falkirk game due to injury and suspension.

Speaking to Hibs TV, Stubbs said: "The reaction from the squad has been really good.
