After the game Development Coach McBride told the club website: "I thought we played some terrific stuff, we moved the ball really well, created chances and probably could have scored a few more. In the first 10 to 15 minutes of the second half we took a while to get back into our stride, but I was delighted with the performance all round tonight.
