

Jason Cummings and Danny Handling in Scotland Under-21 squad



Hibs' youngsters Jason Cummings and Danny Handling (pictured) have both been named in the Scotland under-21 squad for the upcoming friendly against Hungary in Budapest on Thursday 26 March.

This will be Cummings first call-up into the under-21 squad and arrives after he scored his 15th overall goal of the season against Cowdenbeath which means that the 19-year-old currently tops the Scottish Championship's goal chart with 13.

Handling, 21, has previously been capped twice at under-21 level.

Both players are graduates of the Hibernian Academy and have subsequently made an impact at first team level.
