

Heart of Midlothian Ladies 0-2 Hibernian Ladies



Hibernian Ladies beat city rivals Heart of Midlothian Ladies 2-0 at Kings Park, Dalkeith yesterday.

Goals from Lia Tweedie and Kirsty Smith was enough to secure the victory in the first ever competitive match between the teams.

After the game Hibs boss Chris Roberts told the club website: "I was really pleased with the performance from the girls. I felt that in the first half we created a lot of good chances and really should have been out of sight by half-time.

"We totally dominated but were not clinical enough in front of goal. After the break I thought Hearts were much-improved and more of a threat, however I always felt we were comfortable.
