

Lewis Stevenson looking forward to play-off games



Hibs' longest serving player Lewis Stevenson (pictured) has compared the squad's training camp in Spain with a similar trip ahead of the 2007 CIS League Cup and hopes that the outcome is the same.

On that occasion Hibs went on to defeat Kilmarnock to lift the trophy with Stevenson named Man of the Match.

Speaking to Hibs TV from La Manga, Stevenson said: "When we went away to Spain before the League Cup Final, it was for exactly the same reasons – to get away from everything at home and to prepare correctly.
