- Other Scottish racing drivers celebrated include Johnny Dumfries and the Jaguar XJR-9 he drove to victory at the Le Mans 24 Hours race in 1988. Two of Jim Clark's Formula One cars will also be on display
- Dario Franchitti will be showcasing the three cars that came with each of his three victories at the Indianapolis 500. It's a race tradition that the winner gets to take home the pace car from the event.
- The Club Trophy brings together the most incredible models from the UK's premier car clubs. All entries are judged by a team of experts, which in the past have included David Gandy and Prince Michael of Kent
- The Concours of Elegance is a charity fundraising event, and has already donated more than £600,000 to charity. This year the Concours is raising funds for Walking with the Wounded, Action on Addiction and Sir Jackie Stewart's charity, Springfield Motor Racing's Club for Young People.
