

# Hibernian Development Squad 0-3 Kilmarnock Development Squad



A young Hibernian Development Squad lost 3-0 to Kilmarnock at Ainslie Park this afternoon.

Ross Barbour opened the scoring in the 14th minute then an own goal by Ryan Donaldson made it 2-0 just before the break.

A 65th minute a header from ex Hearts' striker Dale Carrick sealed the victory for the visitors.

After the game, Joe McBride, Hibs U20 Development Coach told the club website: "Sean (Brennan) hasn't had a lot of saves to make which was a positive as the make-up of the two sides were different. We were very young and Kilmarnock had five first-team players in their squad, so we played slightly differently today and sat off the game a bit.

"I thought we done well, I just think we didn't make the most of our opportunities when we did steal possession. The players need to start learning quickly that they can't keep shipping goals."
