

What's On In Edinburgh? Bruce, Meg and Me



In 2012, **Gregor Ewing** and his Border Collie **Meg** ('carrier of supplies, listener to my woes, possessor of my only towel') recreated Bonnie Prince Charlie's escape during the 1746 Jacobite rising.

That journey is recorded in *Charlie, Meg and Me*. To celebrate St Andrew's Day, Gregor will be at the **National Library of Scotland**, talking about his new book, ***Bruce, Meg and Me*** (Luath Press), 'One man, one dog and 1,000 miles in the footsteps of Robert the Bruce' in which he and Meg return to the hills.

The pair set off from Dalrigh, near Tyndrum, and finally finished their expedition at Arrochar, following Bruce from his lowest ebb to his ultimate triumph. The afternoon may even include a guest appearance by a certain, well-walked, furry friend....
