

Chris Dagnall to join Hibs on a short-term deal



Chris Dagnall will join Hibs on a short-term deal until the end of the season, subject to international clearance.

The 29-year-old has a wealth of experience at clubs such as Tranmere Rovers, Barnsley and Leyton Orient in England, and, most recently, he has enjoyed time at Kerala Blasters in the Indian Super League.

The Liverpool-born striker told hibernianfc.co.uk, he said: "I'm very excited to be joining the club. I know we are doing really well this season and after coming down to speak to the manager and coaching staff I'm really looking forward to joining in with the lads.
