Herbal cannabis worth £20,000 recovered in Danderhall

Police have charged a 46-year-old man following the recovery of Class B drugs in Danderhall.

Acting on intelligence, officers attended an address in Newton Church Road on Thursday 7 January.

A quantity of herbal cannabis, with a maximum street value of £20,000, was subsequently recovered from within. A three-figure sum of cash was also seized.

A report has been submitted to the Procurator Fiscal.

Sergeant Stuart Aitchison said: "Drug crime is not tolerated within our community, and this was a sizeable recovery of cannabis destined for our streets.
