'Super' John McGinn watched the William Hill Scottish Cup quarter-finals draw with interest yesterday but he is not thinking about facing Inverness Caledonian Thistle as he knows that Hibs still have a major obstacle to overcome first.

"At half time he (Alan Stubbs) said that it was important that we get the next goal and put the pressure on Hearts a wee bit more and we managed to get it a bit later than we would have

liked. we have a never say die attitude in the dressing room and thankfully we got the goal in the last minute.

"It was brilliant, a great atmosphere and something I thrived under. Every footballer wants to play in the big games and thankfully I had the opportunity t play in the Edinburgh derby on Sunday.

"As things stand right now, Hearts are the third best team in the country and for us to come from two goals behind against them was massive. It has given everyone at the club a massive boost but we are just taking each game as it comes.

"If we manage to get through that, then Inverness is a tough tie.

" First and foremost we've got to get by Hearts again, and hopefully we can do that."
