Hibs' midfielder John McGinn has been named in Gordon Strachan's Scotland squads for the upcoming friendlies against Czech Republic and Denmark.

The Scotland National Team Coach has confirmed two squads of 19 for the matches in Prague and Glasgow, with debut international call-ups a feature in both.
