

Witness appeal following collision in Leith



Police have appealed for witnesses after a Suzuki motorbike and Renault Clio collided on Salamander Street in Leith shortly after 4.30pm yesterday which resulted in a motorcyclist being taken to hospital with leg injuries.

Salamander Street was closed between Seafield Place and Baltic Street but reopened at 5.40pm.

A police spokesman said: "The incident, involving a grey coloured Renault Clio and the Suzuki motorbike, happened shortly before 4.40pm on Monday, near to the junction with Carron Place.

"A male motorcyclist sustained a minor leg injury and has been taken to the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh for medical attention. No other injuries have been reported at this time."
