

Hibs' pair nominated for the PFA Scotland Championship Player of the Year



Hibs' duo Jason Cummings and John McGinn have been nominated for the PFA Scotland Player of the Year in the Ladbrokes Championship.

Cummings has already scored 24 goals in all competitions this season whilst McGinn has been capped by Gordon Strachan for Scotland, winning the man of the match on his debut against Denmark last month.

Also on the list is former Hearts' full back Lee Wallace

Nominations have also been announced for League 1 and League 2.
