

Witnesses sought following hit and run in Livingston



Police are appealing for witnesses after a hit and run road collision in Ladywell, Livingston which happened between 8.45 am and 9 am yesterday and involved a black Mercedes car colliding with a Ford Focus on Thymebank.

The impact caused both vehicles to bounce into the air with the Ford Focus landing in bushes on the roadside verge.

The Mercedes driver failed to stop, speeding from the scene of the collision.

It is also missing a licence plate with the registration E18 MDR that was found at the scene and appears to be fake.

The driver is described as being a white man in his late 20's with short black hair and of slim build.

Police Constable James Addison said: "The parked Ford Focus sustained considerable damage and I believe the suspect vehicle would be as badly damaged, specifically to its front nearside area.

"We are looking to speak to anyone who saw this collision and who may have information that can assist with our inquiries.
