Are monsters born or are they created? A mute prisoner sits on death row in a maximum-security prison. He watches and he listens. And he wonders...how do we stop men like me from happening? An investigator unravels unspeakable crimes – she does not let men go to their deaths without a fight. When you walk on death row, you look for the light, for that scrap of sky. Pharmacy presents an imaginative physical theatre adaptation of US author Rene Denfeld's acclaimed novel reflecting on key themes of evil, punishment, clemency and redemption.

Both hard-hitting and tender, **The Enchanted** is a physical theatre production highlighting topical socio/political issues relating to capital punishment, child sex-abuse and the self-perpetuating cycle of violence upon violence.
