

# Police looking for woman in bus CCTV footage



CCTV images of a woman have been released this morning by Edinburgh Police who are investigating a hate crime on a bus.

A 36-year-old woman and her children were subjected to xenophobic comments, and police are looking for the woman in the CCTV footage.

The incident happened around 12:00 hours on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2016 onboard a number 10 Lothian Bus Service travelling on Great Junction Street in Leith.

Officers believe that the woman shown in the images may be able to assist them with their enquiries.



She is described as white, in her early 40s, of skinny build and at the time of the incident, she was wearing a white top and dark trousers.

Constable Thomas Winsor from Leith Police Station said: "The woman pictured in the CCTV footage is of interest to our on going inquiries and I would ask anyone who recognises her to contact police immediately.

"In addition, anyone with any further information relevant to this investigation should also come forward."
