Colin Christian, Fishkeeper Scotland Regional Director, said: "We are in the process of putting the finishing touches to our flagship store within Dobbie's Melville, in time for the official opening weekend on the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} September.

"This is part of a major store roll-out plan which we are really exciting about and on track to complete within the next 12months, taking our total number of stores in Scotland to 14."
