Pavel's four-goal salvo fires him into Elite class top spot

■ Edinburgh Capitals' Russian forward Pavel Vorobyev was today named the Elite League Player of the Week.

The accolade for the 6ft lin, former Chicago Blackhawks right-wing comes after a sensational four-goal salvo as the Murrayfield combine beat Scottish rivals, Braehead Clan, 6-4 in Edinburgh last Sunday.

Three of the 34-year-old Russian sniper's goal came in 13 sensational, third-period minutes and the man from Karaganda has so far scored eight goals and set-up another 11 strikes for 19 points in 14 Elite League games.
