

Four men arrested after teenager knocked unconscious during fight on Easter Road



Four men aged 18, 21, 21 and 28, have been arrested and charged after a 19-year-old man was taken to hospital suffering from a head injury incurred during a fight on Easter Road at around 9.30pm on Friday.

The man, who was knocked unconscious, was taken to Edinburgh Royal Infirmary for treatment and the four men detained nearby.

The incident came in the aftermath of Hibs victory against Dundee United where almost 19,000 attended the fixture.

A Police Scotland spokeswoman said: "Police in Edinburgh are investigating after a 19-year-old man sustained a head injury following an altercation at the junction of Easter Road and Rossie Place around 9.25pm on Friday.

"He was taken by the Scottish Ambulance Service to the Edinburgh Royal Infirmary for treatment.

"Four men were detained shortly afterwards following a disturbance at the junction of Easter Road and London Road.

"They were subsequently arrested and charged and will appear in court at a later date.
