

Cyrenians team up with St Martin's in Frontline Network



Edinburgh based Cyrenians have told us about their latest partnership with the St Martin-in-the-Fields charity.

They are teaming up with the St Martin's Frontline Network to bring together those working on the frontline to tackle homelessness in the capital. The idea is to give everyone a space for mutual support and share examples of best practice.

They held an event recently to get an introduction to St Martin's and find out how this will work. They carried out a variety of activities to share ideas, get introduced to new tools to support collaboration between the charities and discuss what they will do next.

They also discussed lone working and staff wellbeing promoting calls for this scheme to involve more workers dealing with homelessness.
