

Edinburgh Telecoms firm get into the groove



Telecoms firm TenTel have celebrated their record growth with a dance.

The Edinburgh based firm announced that they had recently reached their target of consistently signing up more than 100 customers a day, and to give themselves a pat on the back they went dancing.
