The women's race was won by Kenyan Eddah Jepkosgei. She led from the gun to a six minute victory in 2 hours, 37 minutes and 46 seconds.

Local Scott Hutchison from Tranent was running for Arthritis Research UK and Pulmonary Fibrosis Trust, and to maximise his fundraising efforts he ran both the 5K and 10K races on Saturday and the half and full marathon on Sunday.

After the marathon Scott said: "That's probably the hardest thing I've ever had to do in my life, my body is absolute agony! Half way through the marathon was the hardest part of today, but I'm so chuffed that I finished and can't wait to put my feet up and enjoy a barbecue!"
