

# James Keatings' strike nominated for PFA Goal of the Season



Hibs' striker James Keatings is in the running for the PFA Goal of the Season following his sensational strike against Falkirk in April.

With the scores level at 1-1, the former Hearts' player latched onto a knockdown from Brian Graham before cutting in from the left and curling a shot into the corner of the net with his weaker foot.

Many consider that goal to have been the title clincher as it virtually ruled out Falkirk from the race.
