

Local musician to feature in updated Scottish SPCA TV advert



A musician from Edinburgh is to feature in the updated Scottish SPCA TV advert airing on STV today.

Megan D, 21, originally from Portobello, was found after a search by Scotland's animal welfare charity.

Chief Superintendent Mike Flynn said, "We've been looking to update our television advert for a while now, but we were never able to find the right music.
