Transport for Edinburgh has a very useful app [here](#). The app allows you to find out live departure times and routes to help you plan out your journey.

They also have a ticketing app [here](#) which allows you to buy your tickets in advance and then just activate them ahead of your journey whether on one of the Lothian Buses services or on Edinburgh Trams.

One of our tips is that with a network ticket you can travel all day across the services offered from South Queensferry to Dunbar!
