Witness appeal after 67-yearold man assaulted in Dalkeith

Police are appealing for witnesses following an assault in Dalkeith which took place around 2.40pm yesterday at the junction of Eskbank Road and Morrison's Car-Park.

The 67-year-old victim was punched to the face several times by a man that he'd had an earlier altercation with.

The suspect thereafter left the area in a blue Citroen Berlingo van.

Police Constable Ben Rodriguez from Dalkeith Police Station said: "Although he wasn't seriously injured this was a distressing incident for the victim and his wife who was also in the car.

"At the time of the assault the car park and surrounding area would have been busy with motorists and other shoppers and I'm appealing for anyone that can assist with the police investigation to come forward."
