

Hearts Close in on 14,000 Season Ticket Sales



Hearts have announced they are closing in on their target of selling 14,000 season tickets. The club are just 300 short of last year's record-breaking figure and less than 500 short of the target set for season 2017/18.

The new main stand has sold 80% of available seats and there are less than 200 premium seats available.

Hearts owner and Chief Executive, Ann Budge, paid tribute to the loyalty of the Maroon Army, particularly given the way last season ended and the faltering start made to this campaign.
