Multi-award-nominated, nationally acclaimed musical comedians JONNY & THE BAPTISTS are thrilled to announce THE BEST OF 2012-2017. A barnstorming retrospective of their career to date, the show plays from 13-19 August at their regular Ed Fringe home, Paines Plough's Roundabout at Summerhall.
