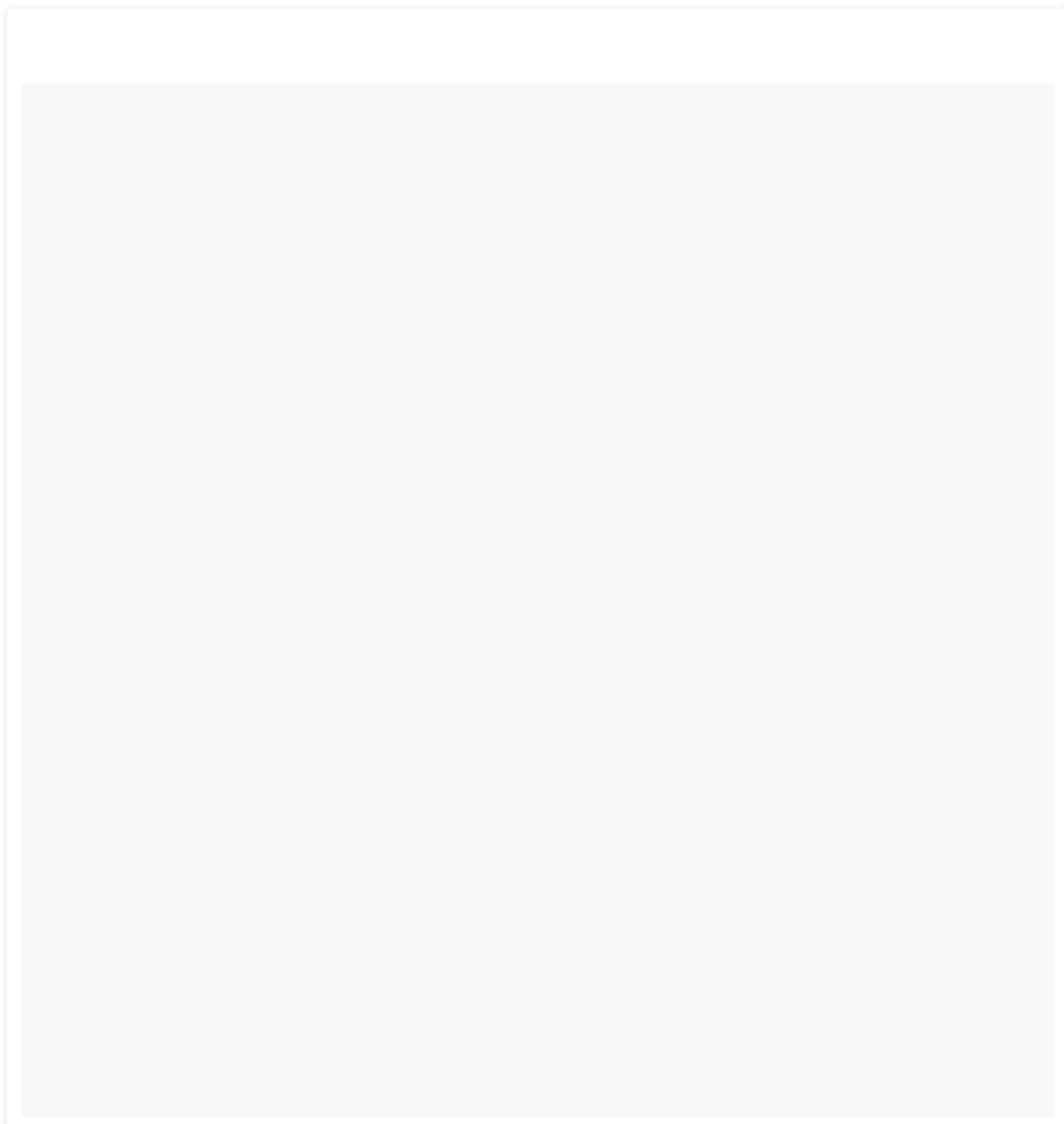


Our pick of the best Edinburgh cafés

Distinctive for its striking green exterior, this cafe features a classic design, with panelled floors and walls and a good selection of homemade cakes and pastries.

The coffee is provided by leading company Square Mile and the baristas are trained by owner, former Barista Champion, Jon Sharp.

Opening hours are 8am-6pm (Mon-Fri) and 9am-6am (weekends).

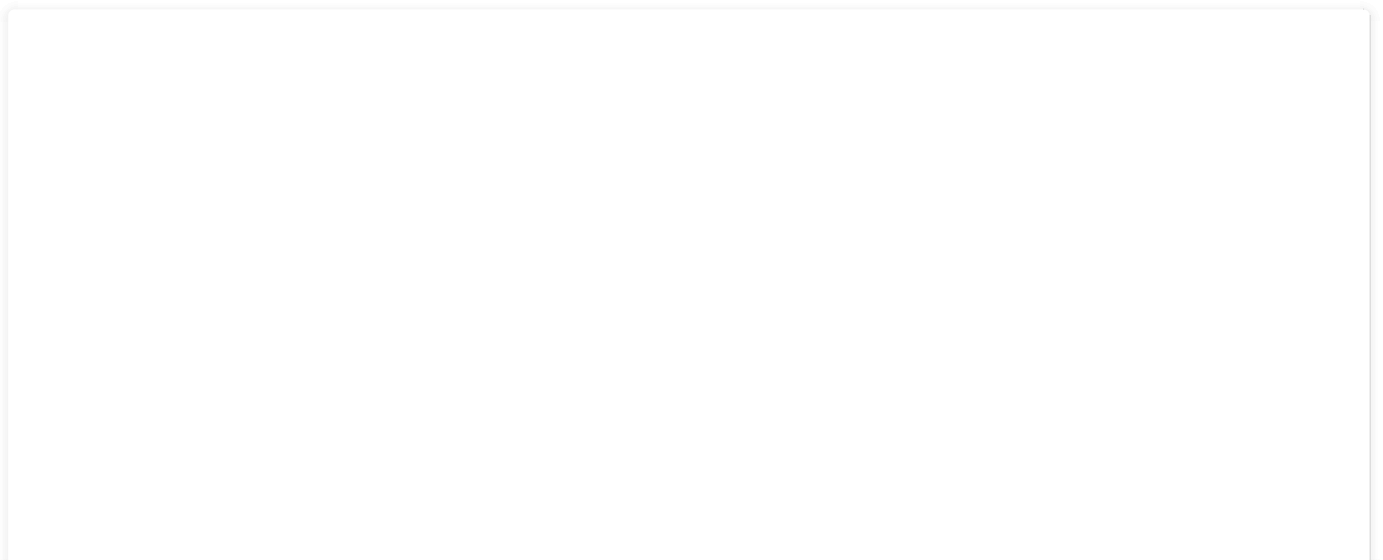


Wellington Coffee |33a George Street| EH2 2HN

House blend is Square Mile, or you could choose an indulgent hot chocolate.

Fruit or cheese scones with bacon or chorizo are delicious and there are lovely cakes available. No WiFi, but there is a wide selection of newspapers and a peaceful atmosphere. High level and low level seating with tables and chairs on the pavement (on a busy corner though!)




experience in the best way possible: all of the enjoyable coffee and treats, none of the Starbucks' corporate soullessness or stressed morning commuters.
